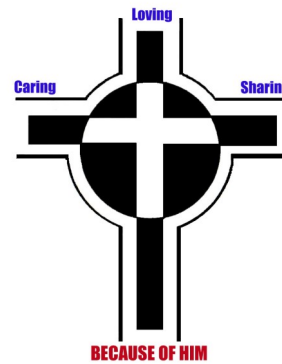

Cheryl Zabroski is the leader of the Sewing for Angels ministry. She recently submitted this article for our information. Little did I know, a simple article in the Democrat Gazette, (pointed out to me by Rose Mary Hall), would lead to an amazing ministry. We are now a nonprofit foundation.

I went to my first meeting of Holy Sews in January of 2012. Those 10 years have flown by.

This ministry is now supplying burial layettes in all 50 states, Canada and the UK. We send them to hospitals and funeral homes, free of charge to all who need them.

To date our group has contributed 9,100 full layettes, 4,657 small blankets, 13,113 hats and 942 tunics. We have worked approximately 31,439 hours.

The statistics I recently read, stated 1 in every 160 pregnancies is a still born baby.

Thank you, each and everyone of you for your support for this ministry.

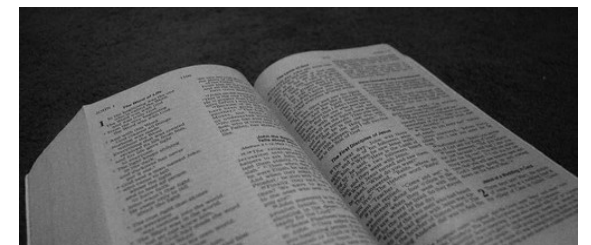
