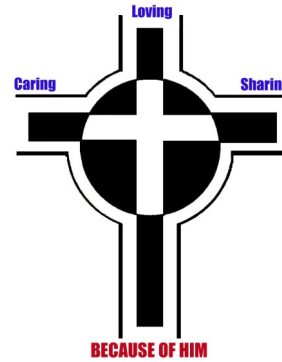

NOTE FROM THE SHEPHERDS

The shepherds continue to be concerned by the spread of COVID-19 and by the number of our members who have recently contracted the disease. We feel that it might be beneficial to some if we explain the thought process that we employed in deciding to reopen our building and to restart our congregational assemblies in spite of our concern.

We know that several throughout the world have begun to view this disease as an endemic rather than a pandemic because of two primary reasons: [1] due to the less severe symptoms and outcomes caused by the current predominate variant and [2] due to the increasing level of vaccinations throughout the world. Since a large number of our members are fully vaccinated and since most people, including our members, continue to engage in most other normal activities [school, work, shopping, eating out, medical appointments, etc.], we felt it appropriate to provide the option of congregational worship for those who desire the opportunity.

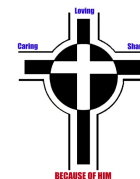
We continue to strongly urge any who feel ill to stay away from our assemblies and we reiterate our advice that any who feel uncomfortable attending the public services should remain at home and participate online.

We will continue to monitor the situation and we will update our response should we feel that changed circumstances warrant a change in the current policies. Room A4 will have a live stream of the service if you prefer to worship with mask only individuals.
