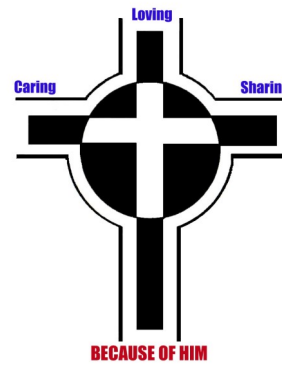

### HOW CAN I SERVE?

When we have new members move here, or be baptized into Christ and added to His church, we give them a servant towel as an answer to the question, "What is there here in this place for me?" New members are given a Ministry Involvement Survey to help us know your interests, talents and experience that you might want to share. We are going to highlight some of the many opportunities offered as a way for us to serve God here.

#### All About Kids

During the school year, each Tuesday, food is bagged and delivered to each of the area schools. Food is purchased from the Food Bank with funds from our church budget, our members, other area churches and service organizations. There are volunteers that come to help unload the food delivery truck when needed. There are approximately 250 bags that go out each week. Besides funds and time, our members donate plastic grocery bags (please double) that are used to deliver the food. Bags can be placed in the resource room or given to any of the listed leaders. At the end of each school year, a final donation box is prepared. The needs of each school (Fountain Lake, Jessieville, and Mountain Pine) are prepared and delivered. Please consider this ministry as a place to serve.



#### LOVE ONE ANOTHER

Many of us do not realize how many of our members obey this commandment in their quiet service to the Lord and our congregation. They give of their time, resources and strength to help our widows, sick and those just needing a helping hand. They prepare communion, coffee, meals, teach, run errands, and serve many ministries with a cheerful heart. They do this without complaint or personal acknowledgment.
