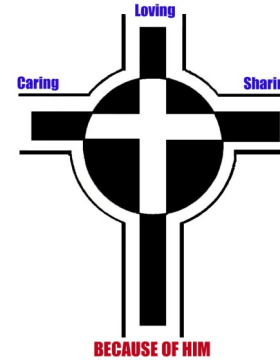

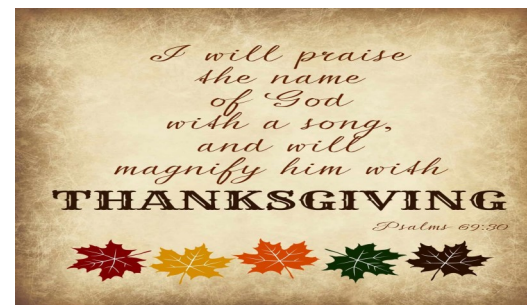
Bear Ladies will meet Nov. 9th at
