VCOC Announcement Regarding In-Person Services

January 27, 2021

The shepherds have decided to allow the use of our building this Thursday, January 28th for the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine. The vaccines will be administered by the Eastgate Pharmacy to people who qualify as part of the Arkansas phase 1b vaccine plan and have registered with the Eastgate Pharmacy. We expect to have over 1,000 people in our building on Thursday related to this program. Please do not call the church office, as we already have all the volunteer required to aid in the program and the program is administered by the pharmacy, not our church.

The decision to allow use of our building was made despite our long-standing and continuing limitation on our building use to schedule-in-person services for our congregation because the shepherd view this opportunity as a means for us to participate in the effort to stem the harmful and deadly effects of the COVID-19 virus.

As a result of the large number of people in our building on Thursday, the shepherds have decided that, out of an abundance of caution and to protect the most vulnerable among us, there will be no in-person services at our building this coming Sunday, January 31st and Wednesday, February 3rd. There will be online services for the Sunday morning and Sunday evening services, but no online services on Wednesday, February 3rd. The shepherds will re-evaluate circumstances at their meeting on February 3rd to decide when to resume in-person services.

Dear Church,

Due to the health issues we have had over the past two years, we have come to the conclusion that it is in the best interest of all our family that Cynthia and I move closer to one of our kids. Therefore, we are in the process of moving to a campus facility in Collierville, TN. (15-20 minutes from our daughter) sometime in mid-March/early April.

Due to the activities involved in having to downsize, get rid of "stuff" and sell a home, my last day as one of your shepherds will be Sunday, January 31st. I want to thank each of you for all the support you have given to your shepherds and your confidence in me during these many years of service.

Having moved often during our 60+ years, Cynthia and I have been members of a number of congregations but none compare to the love, friendliness, care, concern and outreach/evangelism/mission mindedness of this congregation. We will truly miss you all!

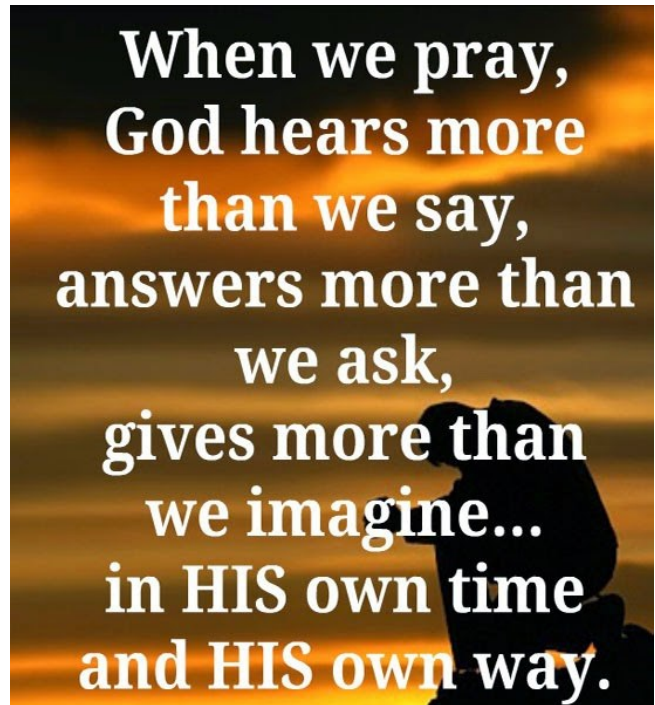
